Biography

Dr. Catherine Racowsky is Director of the ART Laboratory at Brigham & Women’s Hospital in Boston, Massachusetts and Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Harvard Medical School. She is a past Associate Editor of Human Reproduction and Fertility & Sterility, and is currently an Associate Editor for Human Reproduction Open and a member of the editorial boards of Fertility and Sterility and the Journal of Assisted Reproduction and Genetics. She has authored over 120 peer-reviewed papers on various aspects of mammalian egg and embryo physiology, has published numerous news releases and book chapters, and has co-edited seven books.

Her research interests include investigating the effects of maternal and environmental factors on egg quality, studying the molecular and cellular mechanisms underlying egg maturation in vivo and in vitro, expanding methodologies for assessing human embryo developmental competency, and improving quality control and quality management in the clinical IVF laboratory.
