**Biography**

**Dr. Fukuda** is graduated from Kansai Medical University (M.D.) in 1978 and finished residency at Kyoto University Hospital. He received awards from AFS (present ASRM) in 1992 and JSFI (Jpn Soc. for Fertil. & Implant.) in 2000. He is a major contributor in IVM and started outpatient Falloposcopic tuboplasty first in Japan. He is a board-certified OB/GYN specialist with subspecialty of Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility subspecialist. He holds HCLD (high complexity laboratory director) certified by American Board of Bioanalyst in the United States.
