Biography

Dr. Benjamin Tsang is Professor of Obstetrics & Gynaecology and Cellular & Molecular Medicine, University of Ottawa. Dr. Tsang is also a Senior Scientist in the Chronic Disease Program, Ottawa Hospital Research Institute and World Class University Professor of Biomodulation at the Seoul National University. Dr. Tsang joined the University of Ottawa in 1980 as the Director, Reproductive Biology Unit. He served as the Associate Chair (Research) of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology as well as the Director of Research at the Ottawa Civic Hospital.

Professor Tsang is internationally recognized for his translational research in women's health and diseases. He has advanced the current understanding on the basic mechanisms governing normal ovarian follicular growth and offered important insights into the pathophysiology of anovulatory infertility. His research on the molecular basis of chemoresistant ovarian cancer has provided key information for the development of prognostic markers, and new and effective therapy for chemoresistant ovarian cancer. Professor Tsang has received numerous honours and awards, including the Canadian Fertility and Andrology Society Award of Excellence in Reproductive Medicine, the Ottawa Centre for Research and Innovations Research Award, the Ottawa Regional Cancer Foundation Angel Award for cancer research excellence, and the J David Grimes Research Career Achievement Award. He has contributed over 210 full-length original publications and holds 4 patents.
