Biography

Dr. Ko-En Huang has been Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology and Superintendent Emeritus at Chang Gung University and Chang Gung Memorial Hospital in Kaohsiung, Taiwan since 1998. He is also an Adjunct Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology at the University of Rochester. Dr. Huang is a Reproductive Endocrinologist and a Board Certified Fellow of American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists.

Dr. Huang graduated from the College of Medicine of National Taiwan University (NTU) in 1959. He served as a faculty member of NTU and was Associate Professor until recruited by the University of Rochester (U of R) in 1977. He was then associate professor of U of R until invited to be Professor of OBG of Cheng Kung University and Director of Cheng Kung University Hospital in 1992 , where he worked until 1998.

Dr. Huang was the founding president of the Taiwanese Menopause Society and Taiwan Osteoporosis Association. He was President of the Asia Pacific Menopause Society from 1994-1997, and Executive Board Member of International Menopause Society (IMS) from 2008-2014. He has been an Editorial Board Member of Journal of North American Menopause Society (NAMS).

Dr. Huang has published more than 160 peer reviewed papers in the area of Obstetrics and Gynecology.
