Biography

Assoc Professor Dr. Kamthorn Pruksananonda graduated from Chulalongkorn University, Bangkok, Thailand. After graduation he had postgrad training in Obstetrics & Gynecology and subspecialised in Reproductive Medicine from Chulalongkorn University. In 1989, he got the Rockefeller Foundation Fellowship Award to be a Research Fellow at the University of Pennsylvania, Philadelphia, U.S.A., and Young Gynaecologist Award from AOFOG in 1993. Now he works as a lecturer and researcher at Chulalongkorn University. He published more than 40 research papers and book chapters. His contribution with researcher as a co-author in the book chapter: Hormonal regulation of uterine complement. His area of interest including A.R.T., Infertility, Endometriosis, Stem Cells, iPS, epigenetics in endometriosis, PCOS. and ethical aspects of ART. He was past Chairman of Reproductive Medicine Subcommittee, the Royal Thai College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists, Ethical committee in the Thai Medical Council, committee member of National Legislative Assembly, Vice President Thai Society for Reproductive Medicine, and now the Director of Chulalongkorn A.R.T program. He actively involves in several national and international guidelines drafting. He was invited reviewer for several scientific journals such as J Med Assoc Thai, PLoS One.
