

Biography

Dr. Mei-Jou Chen is Professor of Obstetrics & Gynecology, School of Medicine, National Taiwan University (NTU), Professor of Livia Shangyu Wan Scholarship, NTU, and staff physician of Division Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility (REI), Department of OBS/GYN, National Taiwan University Hospital (NTUH).

She received her medical degree from the College of Medicine, Taipei Medical University, Taipei, Taiwan in 1998 and completed OBS/GYN resident and REI specialty fellowship training in NTUH. Then she became an OBS/GYN clinical staff of NTUH since 2004. She received her Ph.D. degree in 2009 from Graduate Institute of Clinical Medicine, NTU, and became a full professor in Department of OBS/GYN, School of Medicine, NTU, since 2017.

Her main interests are in reproductive medicine, endocrinology and metabolism and she leads an active research team focusing on the research of polycystic ovary syndrome and has authored more than 80 peer-reviewed publications. She actively devoted in many academic societies, including Taiwanese Association of OBS/GYN, Taiwanese Menopause Society and Taiwanese Society of Reproductive Medicine. She serves as an editorial board member of Scientific Reports and Taiwanese Journal of OBS/GYN. She is the recipient of several academic research awards for her contributions related to the reproductive endocrinology including the Young Investigator Award of National Science Council of Taiwan (Ta-You Wu Memorial Award, 2012) and others.
