Biography

Professor Wang obtained the degree of bachelor in medicine at Kaohsiung Medical University, Kaohsiung, Taiwan in 1981. His residency training in the field of Obstetrics & Gynecology was in the hospital affiliated to Kaohsiung Medical University from 1985 to 1987. In 1988, he studied as a Ph.D. student in the Department of Reproductive Physiology, St. Bartholomew's Hospital Medical College, University of London, London, U.K. and obtained the degree of Ph.D. in 1991. During the Ph.D. course, Prof. Wang purified insulin-like growth factor-binding protein-1 (IGFBP-1) from amniotic fluid and set up a radioimmunoassay for IGFBP-1. Using this assay, Prof Wang published a series of paper concerning the relationship of IGFBP-1 and fetal growth during pregnancy.

Prof Wang is now working as a professor and attending physician in the subdivision of reproductive medicine, Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, Chang-Gung Memorial Hospital, Lin-Kou Medical Center, Taoyuan, Taiwan. In the meantime, he is also the director and professor of Graduate Institute of Clinical Medical Science, Chang-Gung University, Taoyuan, Taiwan.
