**Dr. William Yeung** is a Professor in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, University of Hong Kong. Professor Yeung completed his PhD degree at the University of Hong Kong. He did his post-doctoral training in the Department of Anatomy, University of Bristol, United Kingdom. He joined the University of Hong Kong in 1989. Since then, he worked as an embryologist in the assisted reproduction program of the University. He is currently the Scientific Director of the program. He is also the laboratory-in-charge of the University of Hong Kong-Shenzhen Hospital, the University of Hong Kong-Family Planning Association Andrology Laboratory and the Kwong Wah Hospital Reproductive Medicine Centre. Recently, he was elected as an Honorary Fellow of the Hong Kong College of Obstetricians and Gynaceologists. His research interest is on regulation of sperm functions and interaction between the spermatozoa and embryos with the female reproductive tract.
