Biography

**Prof. Tzeng Chii-Ruey** is Director of Center for Reproductive Medicine at Taipei Medical University Hospital since 1994 and he was Chair of OB/GYN from 1994 to 2017 and Dean of the College of Medicine at TMU from 2004 to 2013. He obtained an MPH degree from Harvard University (1980-1981) and he completed his fellowship training in Reproductive Endocrinology and Fertility from 1981-1983 in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Brigham and Women's Hospital, Harvard Medical School.

Professor Tzeng has undertaken two pioneering projects in Taiwan: the first test-tube baby in 1985 and the first autologous mitochondria transfer in 2002. He has received the Prize Poster Award 3 times at ESHRE annual meetings. He obtained the STAR Award 4 times from ASRM. In 2012, he received the "Lifetime Achievement Award" from The Global Chinese Association for Reproductive Medicine. Professor Tzeng served as President of Pacific Society for Reproductive Medicine from 2008-2014. He is the board member of International Society for Fertility Preservation and World Endometriosis Society, and he is the president of the Asia Pacific Initiative on Reproduction (ASPIRE) (2016-2018) and the president of Taiwan Endometriosis Society. Professor Tzeng has been invited as a guest speaker in numerous grand conferences around the world for more than 120 times. He has published over 194 peer review papers in the field of reproductive medicine.
